

BLANKET SQUARES FOR BEDS



CHOOSE YOUR MATERIALS

- A washable synthetic/mix wool, preferably 8ply. Use any colour and any knitting/crochet pattern you like.
- Knitting needles/crochet hook of any size
- Yarn needle to finish the ends

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Knit or crochet 20cm x 20cm squares using any colour or pattern (preferably 8ply washable synthetic/mix wool)
- 2 Trace and cut out a 20cm x 20cm square on paper. Check your knitted/crochet square's tension using the template
- 3 Finish the wool ends using a yarn needle
- 4 Bring your completed squares to Roundabout Canberra's warehouse (**80 Beaurepaire Crescent, Holt, ACT**). Hand to staff or drop them in the donation trolley at the door.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

- 5 We will organise squares into sets of 48 (enough for one blanket)
- 6 "Sewing Fairies" take a set to crochet or sew together (6 squares wide by 8 long). We always need helpers to sew squares together, you can collect the squares and a how to guide from Holt.
- 7 Completed blankets are returned to Roundabout Canberra and gifted to a local child.
